Academic system	Undergraduate exchange students can take up to 30 ECTS per semester
Language requirements	To enroll in French courses, exchange students need an European language level in French (B2 minimum)
	To enroll in English courses, exchange students need an European language level in English (B2 minimum)
Language support	French as a foreign language for all levels year-long (free of charge), for up to 6 hours a week and 6 ECTS per semester (12 ECTS a year).
